but a unique course for everyone who likes reading in English!*

In class we will get together to read two or three novels and then discuss, reflect, interpret and compare them. Of course, we will also take a look at film or theater adaptations.

Topics will depend on the group's interest, but might cover issues such as "The Individual and Society", "Utopia and Reality", "Who am I?" or "All-time favorites".

A great chance to be creative and experience new aspects of the English language and learn tools needed when discussing literature (also helpful for German class).

While reading you will acquire the following skills:

- get acquainted with different cultures and mindsets
- use the text to reflect upon your own life, gain new insights and change perspectives
- use different reading techniques and learn how to approach a text
- analyze the structure of a text and key scenes
- assess the way the characters behave and their motivation
- learn to understand and use new language expressions, idioms, phrases, and structures

This course will be taught in English. The reading material has to be acquired by the students themselves.

You will receive an oral grade and write a short test each semester.
